Fines are necessary to ensure that we have a minimum set of standards but also that the kitty pays for certain items, for example; Website, Stickers, Printing of Fine Cards and of course the brass plate on the Wooden Spoon.

Fines will be levied at the following rates;

Failure to produce Fine Card for inspection	€2
Found to be in possession of someone else's Fine Card	€2
Having your Fine Card interfered with	€2
Illegible Sporting Item entry	€10
Being late to any JP session (only Sat and Sunday)	€10
Not wearing approved items of JP clothing	€10
Being late for the bus on Monday	€100 – cause that's your taxi fare!
Same Pub all night	€5
Only pints consumed	€3
No pint of Water	€5
Damage to provided housing (per incident)	€50 minimum, to be assessed

If staying in recommended accommodation, you must be respectful at all times; to the property and their neighbours.
